Podium discussion at the round table: Religion Violence Peace

14.30 p.m. - 16.00 p.m.:

Commemoration of the dead of 9/11 and the victims of the subsequent military conflicts as well as peace testimonies of the religions with clergy from various religions

16.00 p.m. - 16.45 p.m.:

On the 'Platz des 18. März':

Forming of a peace dove by young and old from various religions wearing blue clothing

Musical conclusion at sunset
